

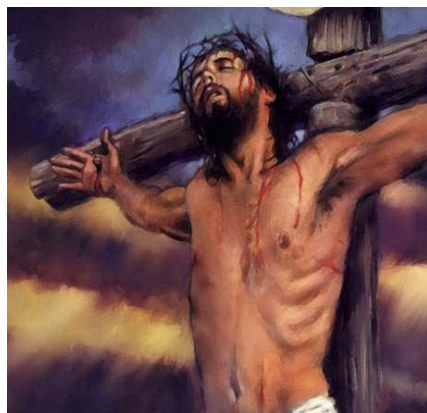


# Yfc/kzn prayer calendar ...april 2010
