Thank God for His faithful provision to the work of Youth for Christ.

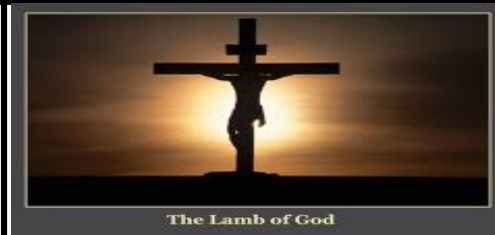
Monday 11
