

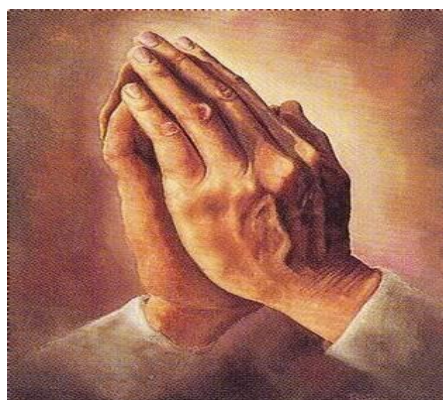


Yfc/kzn prayer calendar ..july2009
