Pray for new girls who will come to live at Tennyson House now that there is space again. Pray for staff as they build relationships with them.

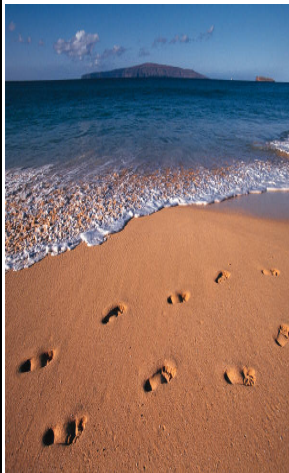
Sunday 16
