Pray for open hearts and doors as we begin to advertise and appeal for sponsorship commitments for 2012.

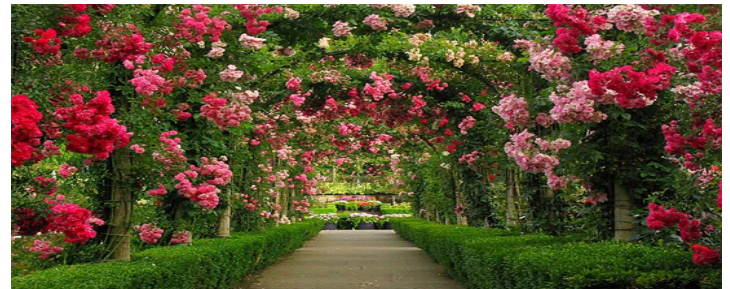
**Wednesday 14**
